Definitions:

Live Instruction	Teachers will be holding live instruction with students during this time. During live instruction, teachers will use some or all of these elements: explain concepts, hold discussions, work through problems, facilitate small group work, provide time for independent work, and much more. The facilitation of live instruction will vary from class to class.
On Demand Instruction	On demand instruction is student-initiated support time. During this time, students may work independently on teacher provided lessons and tasks as well as seek support/help from their teachers. Teachers will support students in a variety of ways including but not limited to: answering students questions sent via email, connecting with students on Teams to explain concepts and/or provide targeted instruction.
Stella Workshop	Teachers will be holding live instruction with students during this time. It will be a blend of content areas and projects.
Intervention	Stella teachers and/or Rose Hill specialists may hold academic support sessions and request small groups of students to attend based on need and/or topic. This time is teacher/specialist-initiated. Students should plan to attend these sessions if requested by a teacher/specialist. Teacher will specify if that day will be small-group or whole-group live instruction.
Student Work Time	Students will work <i>independently</i> during this time. Teachers will not be available for support due to teacher planning, professional development, and team meetings.
