

STELLA SCHOLA MIDDLE SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST 2022 – 2023

- Large (1.5 2 in.) three ring binder (metal ring kind; do not recommend zipper kind as they don't fit in the desks)
- Pencil pouch for binder
- Pencil box/container for desk (one)
- Sharpened pencils (mechanical pencils are okay, but be sure you have lead and a few regular pencils as back up)
- Black/blue ball point pens (not the erasable kind)
- White-out correcting tape (not the liquid kind)
- Large eraser (Pentel Hi-Polymer Eraser is best)
- Ruler
- Notebook paper (put in back of notebook) WHITE PAPER ONLY
- Centimeter grid paper (will be used in math)
- Eight subject dividers (teacher will guide setting these up during the first week of school)
- Scissors (not the small kind; yes, we do use these a lot)
- Glue sticks (not the liquid kind; yes, we use these a lot)
- Correcting pens (non-black; not marker)
- Highlighters for note-taking
- Large set of colored pencils for art (not Roseart, they are too waxy; yes, we do use these a lot)
- A few regular-sized (fine point) black Sharpie markers
- One or two ultra-fine point black Sharpie marker
- Single subject spiral notebook best if pages can NOT rip out (70 pages is okay, but may need a 2nd one later in the year if handwriting is large)
- Headphones/earbuds for laptops
- A family-sized box of Kleenex for our class
- A container/package of wet anti-bacterial wipes for our class
- Two reams of paper for school photocopying (one white and one color see below)
 - 6th Grade: pastel blue
 - 7th Grade: pastel yellow
 - 8th Grade: pastel pink/green/purple
 - These items are for first semester. There will be a second round of paper, Kleenexes, and wipes needed for second semester around January.
- Small, hand-held and quiet pencil sharpener (optional, recommended)
- Water bottle to keep discretely under your desk (optional, recommended)
- It is our expectation that you always have your own book to read (teachers will assign independent reading during the school day at times)
- <u>Stella Schola will provide</u> a planner to put in the front of your binder
